Annex 1.1: Access to clean water and NFI goods for Libnatey IDP



Halima Hussein Osman, 29 years old is a resident of Libantey village, Elwak district Gedo region Somalia. she has been living here since birth to 2019, she is a widow with a total household of 5 (2males and 3 females). She was a pastoralist and mainly depends on livestock products as her main source of

income to sustain his family. Halima often sells animals or milk and uses the money to pay for food, health service. For past 3 years of drought water sources, pasture decreased, animal grew thinner producing no milk.

As a result, Halima and her family were displaced and moved Libantey village IDP. ARIDLIFE with funding from USAID/Mercy Corps rehabilitated a shallow well and provided village kitchen items, sanitation kits and clean water for household use.

She thanked ARIDLIFE for the timely support and requested for food for her family and fodder for livestock so they can survive until the next rainy season.
